- Released May 2015
- Same code base as 8.1.1.14
- Monthly patch sets
- Serious improvements to OUI performance
- More functionality with OUI than previous versions
- PS 5 optional IRM

IP 2016



- Should be released in April 2016
- RESTful web services
- No more HI or SI only OUI
- New OUI applications: Partner, Consumer and Mobile
- Net Charts replaced with JQuery Charts
- Webmaster folder concept is gone put all files directly on web server
- SAP iAnywhere local database is gone
- IRM, DB management and UPT updates including UPT Analytics

- Desktop integration Siebel Agent (DISA)
- Outlook to Siebel drag & drop
- CTI notifications.
- CalDAV, CardDAV and Calendar enhancements
- Developer Workspaces
- Search enhancements
- Siebel Composer

Release Themes



- Visual

Open UI All The Way

COLLABORATE 16

- No HI or SI
- Installation simplified
- Removal of many .cfg files
- Webmaster folder is gone
- Folder restructuring
- Obsolete server parameters
- Obsolete SWT tags
- Webtempl folder changes
- Eappweb\public changes



Elastic List Applets



- Minimal display by occupying only the height needed to display records
- Default # of rows acts as max height
- Enabled by default for all list applets
- System preference to turn on/off

Oracle XE Database



- Entry level Oracle 11g R2
- Replaces SAP's iAnywhere database starting 15.5
- Requires 1G of memory and 1 CPU
- Installation is very easy
- Can have multiple XE databases
- Siebel has provided a utility to switch between databases
- XE_DBF folder

Calendar, CalDAV and CardDAV



- Siebel Calendar has been enhanced in several ways
- New system preferences to control calendar
- CalDAV and CardDAV provide integration between Siebel and any compliant client such as iOS and Android
- CalDAV is bidirectional
- CardDAV is one way only from Siebel to client
- 3rd party plugin is required for Outlook and Android

 iOS supports natively

Workspaces



- Fundamental element of composer
- Can and should use instead of local XE database
- Master and user workspaces
- No check out or object locking
- Any user can edit any object
- Solves many issues and starting in 17 will be the only option
- Versioning and ability to see all changes made in a release
- Conflicts and conflict resolution Mini IRM
- Flatten workspace
- Ability to go back to any version
- Delta changes tracked only
- Submit for delivery instead of check in
- Few object types not enabled WFP, Table, Tasks, Dock

Desktop Integration



- DISA Desktop Integration
 - Browsers sunset NPAPI
 - Browser limits what you can do
 - Java framework used by Siebel but you can also add your own .jar files to do whatever you need
 - Inline attachment edit, CTI hoteling, Outlook integration, batch fulfillment
 - Small Oracle icon
 - Can backport to 14/15
 - Java application and .properties file
- Outlook drag and drop
 - Fixes Outlook issue not Siebel issue
 - Works all the way back to 13
- Notifications
 - Helps CTI users not miss call. HI came to front on incoming call

RESTful Web Services



- Going to be a big part of Siebel going forward
- Used by Composer
- Better than SOAP in many ways
- Consuming and offering data in JSON format
- New server architecture
 - Tomcat web server
 - No SWE .war file instead
 - Reverse proxy
 - Proxy OM starts and stops Tomcat
- Special integration object REST ROWID key


- Single field search



Siebel and the Cloud




- Customers are starting to move their Siebel to the Cloud
